4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 843.010, Insurance Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 843.010. APPLICABILITY OF CERTAIN PROVISIONS TO
8	GOVERNMENTAL HEALTH BENEFIT PLANS. (a) Sections 843.306(f) and
9	843.363(a)(4) do not apply to coverage under:
10	(1) the child health plan program under Chapter 62,
11	Health and Safety Code, or the health benefits plan for children
12	under Chapter 63, Health and Safety Code; or
13	(2) a Medicaid program, including a Medicaid managed
14	care program operated under Chapter 533, Government Code.
15	(b) Section 843.3046 applies to:
16	(1) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551;
17	(2) a basic plan under Chapter 1575;
18	(3) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579;
19	(4) basic coverage under Chapter 1601;
20	(5) a Medicaid managed care program operated under
21	Chapter 533, Government Code; and
22	(6) the child health plan program under Chapter 62,
23	Health and Safety Code.
24	SECTION 2. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is

- 1 amended by adding Section 843.3046 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 843.3046. CAMPUS-BASED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS.
- 3 (a) In this section:
- 4 (1) "Campus-based mental health professional" means a
- 5 licensed clinical social worker, professional counselor,
- 6 psychological associate, or psychologist who provides mental
- 7 <u>health care services primarily or exclusively at a campus of a</u>
- 8 school district or an open-enrollment charter school.
- 9 (2) "Open-enrollment charter school" means a school
- 10 that has been granted a charter under Subchapter D, Chapter 12,
- 11 Education Code.
- 12 (3) "School district" means a public school district
- 13 <u>created under the laws of this state.</u>
- 14 (b) If a health maintenance organization includes mental
- 15 health care services in the services covered by the health
- 16 <u>maintenance organization's health care plan</u>, the health
- 17 maintenance organization may not reject the initial application of
- 18 a campus-based mental health professional to contract with the
- 19 health maintenance organization to provide mental health care
- 20 services on behalf of the health maintenance organization based on
- 21 <u>a determination that the health maintenance organization has</u>
- 22 <u>contracted with sufficient qualified mental health care providers</u>
- 23 in the applicant's geographic area.
- (c) A campus-based mental health professional who applies
- 25 to a health maintenance organization to contract with the health
- 26 maintenance organization to provide mental health care services on
- 27 behalf of the health maintenance organization is entitled to an

- 1 <u>expedited decision on the application.</u>
- 2 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 848, Insurance Code, is
- 3 amended by adding Section 848.111 to read as follows:
- 4 Sec. 848.111. CAMPUS-BASED MENTAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS.
- 5 (a) In this section:
- 6 (1) "Campus-based mental health professional" means a
- 7 licensed clinical social worker, professional counselor,
- 8 psychological associate, or psychologist who provides mental
- 9 health care services primarily or exclusively at a campus of a
- 10 school district or an open-enrollment charter school.
- 11 (2) "Open-enrollment charter school" means a school
- 12 that has been granted a charter under Subchapter D, Chapter 12,
- 13 Education Code.
- 14 (3) "School district" means a public school district
- 15 <u>created under the laws of this state.</u>
- 16 (b) If a health care collaborative includes mental health
- 17 care services in the services covered by the health care
- 18 collaborative's health care plan, the health care collaborative may
- 19 not reject the initial application of a campus-based mental health
- 20 professional to contract with the health care collaborative to
- 21 provide mental health care services as part of the health care
- 22 <u>collaborative's delivery network based on a determination that the</u>
- 23 <u>health care collaborative has contracted with sufficient qualified</u>
- 24 mental health care providers in the applicant's geographic area.
- 25 (c) A campus-based mental health professional who applies
- 26 to a health care collaborative for inclusion in the health care
- 27 collaborative's delivery network is entitled to an expedited

1 decision on the application. 2 SECTION 4. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is 3 amended by adding Section 1301.0516 to read as follows: 4 Sec. 1301.0516. CERTAIN CAMPUS-BASED MENTAL HEALTH 5 SERVICES. (a) In this section: 6 (1) "Campus-based mental health professional" means a licensed clinical social worker, professional counselor, 7 psychological associate, or psychologist who provides mental 8 health care services primarily or exclusively at a campus of a 9 10 school district or an open-enrollment charter school. (2) "Open-enrollment charter school" means a school 11 12 that has been granted a charter under Subchapter D, Chapter 12, 13 Education Code. (3) "School district" means a public school district 14 15 created under the laws of this state. (b) Notwithstanding any other law, this section applies to: 16 17 (1) a basic coverage plan under Chapter 1551; (2) a basic plan under Chapter 1575; 18 19 (3) a primary care coverage plan under Chapter 1579; 20 and 21 (4) basic coverage under Chapter 1601. (c) If an insurer offers a preferred provider benefit plan 22

that includes mental health care services in the services covered

by the plan, the insurer may not reject the initial application of a

campus-based mental health professional to contract for

designation as a preferred provider under the plan based on a

determination that the insurer has contracted with sufficient

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- 1 qualified mental health care providers in the applicant's
- 2 geographic area.
- 3 (d) A campus-based mental health professional who applies
- 4 to an insurer for designation as a preferred provider is entitled to
- 5 an expedited decision on the application.
- 6 SECTION 5. (a) Section 843.3046, Insurance Code, as added
- 7 by this Act, applies only to an application to contract with a
- 8 health maintenance organization submitted on or after the effective
- 9 date of this Act. An application submitted before that date is
- 10 governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective
- 11 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 12 purpose.
- 13 (b) Section 848.111, Insurance Code, as added by this Act,
- 14 applies only to an application to contract with a health care
- 15 collaborative submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 16 An application submitted before that date is governed by the law as
- 17 it existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and
- 18 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 19 (c) Section 1301.0516, Insurance Code, as added by this Act,
- 20 applies only to an application to contract with an insurer
- 21 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 22 application submitted before that date is governed by the law as it
- 23 existed immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 24 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
