The term includes a detachable firearm 15 magazine. 16 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), an agency of this state or a political subdivision of this state, and a law 17 enforcement officer or other person employed by an agency of this 18 state or a political subdivision of this state, may not contract 19 with or in any other manner provide assistance to a federal agency 20 or official with respect to the enforcement of a federal statute, 21 order, rule, or regulation purporting to regulate a firearm, a 22 23 firearm accessory, or firearm ammunition if the statute, order, rule, or regulation imposes a prohibition, restriction, or other 24

1	regulation, such as a capacity or size limitation or a registration
2	requirement, that does not exist under the laws of this state.
3	(c) This section does not prohibit compliance with the
4	national instant criminal background check system in the manner
5	required by 18 U.S.C. Section 922.
6	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
7	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
~	

8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
