- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 229.001, Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding any other law, including Section 43.002
- 9 of this code and Chapter 251, Agriculture Code, a municipality may
- 10 not adopt or enforce regulations relating to:
- 11 (1) the transfer, sale, purchase, private ownership,
- 12 keeping, transportation, manufacture, licensing, or registration
- 13 of firearms, air guns, knives, ammunition, or firearm or air gun
- 14 supplies; or
- 15 (2) the discharge of a firearm or air gun at a sport
- 16 shooting range.
- 17 <u>(a-1)</u> A municipality may not impose a tax on firearms, air
- 18 guns, knives, ammunition, or firearm or air gun supplies, other
- 19 than a tax authorized by state law.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 236.002, Local Government Code, is
- 21 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) Notwithstanding any other law, including Chapter 251,
- 24 Agriculture Code, a county may not adopt or enforce regulations

- 1 relating to:
- 2 (1) the transfer, <u>sale</u>, <u>purchase</u>, private ownership,
- 3 keeping, transportation, <u>manufacture</u>, licensing, or registration
- 4 of firearms, air guns, knives, ammunition, or firearm or air gun
- 5 supplies; or
- 6 (2) the discharge of a firearm or air gun at a sport
- 7 shooting range.
- 8 (a-1) A county may not impose a tax on firearms, air guns,
- 9 knives, ammunition, or firearm or air gun supplies, other than a tax
- 10 <u>authorized by state law.</u>
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
