- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 107.016, Family Code, is amended to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 Sec. 107.016. CONTINUED REPRESENTATION; DURATION OF
- 9 APPOINTMENT. In a suit filed by a governmental entity in which
- 10 termination of the parent-child relationship or appointment of the
- 11 entity as conservator of the child is requested:
- 12 (1) an order appointing the Department of Family and
- 13 Protective Services as the child's <u>temporary</u> managing conservator
- 14 may provide for the continuation of the appointment of the guardian
- 15 ad litem or attorney ad litem for the child for any period set by the
- 16 court; [and]
- 17 (2) an order appointing the Department of Family and
- 18 Protective Services as the child's permanent managing conservator
- 19 shall provide for the continuation of the appointment of the
- 20 attorney ad litem for the child as long as the child remains in the
- 21 conservatorship of the department; and
- 22 <u>(3)</u> an attorney appointed under this subchapter to
- 23 serve as an attorney ad litem for a parent or an alleged father
- 24 continues to serve in that capacity until the earliest of:

- 1 (A) the date the suit affecting the parent-child
- 2 relationship is dismissed;
- 3 (B) the date all appeals in relation to any final
- 4 order terminating parental rights are exhausted or waived; or
- 5 (C) the date the attorney is relieved of the
- 6 attorney's duties or replaced by another attorney after a finding
- 7 of good cause is rendered by the court on the record.
- 8 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply to a
- 9 suit affecting the parent-child relationship filed before, on, or
- 10 after the effective date of this Act.
- 11 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
