A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

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1-21 relating to recommendations regarding instruction in public 1-22 1-23 schools to prevent the use of e-cigarettes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 28.004(c), Education Code, is amended to read as follows:

- (c) The local school health advisory council's duties include recommending:
- the number of hours of instruction to be provided (1)in health education;
- (2) policies, procedures, strategies, and curriculum appropriate for specific grade levels designed to prevent obesity, cardiovascular disease, Type 2 diabetes, and mental health concerns through coordination of:
 - (A) health education;
 - (B) physical education and physical activity;
 - (C) nutrition services;
 - parental involvement; (D)
- (E) instruction to prevent the use of e-cigarettes, as defined by Section 161.081, Health and Safety Code, and tobacco;
 - (F) school health services;
 - (G) counseling and guidance services;
 - a safe and healthy school environment; and (H)
 - (I)school employee wellness;
- (3)appropriate grade levels and methods of instruction for human sexuality instruction;
- strategies for integrating (4)the curriculum components specified by Subdivision (2) with the following elements in a coordinated school health program for the district:
 - (A) school health services;
 - counseling and guidance services; (B)
 - a safe and healthy school environment; and
 - (D) school employee wellness; and
- (5) if feasible, joint use agreements or strategies for collaboration between the school district and community organizations or agencies.
- 1-56 1-57 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-58 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-59 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-60 1-61 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
