BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 61.501(1), Education Code, is amended to 7 read as follows:

"Medical school" means the medical school at The 8 (1)9 University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, the medical 10 school at The University of Texas Southwestern Medical Center, the medical school at The University of Texas Health Science Center at 11 12 San Antonio, The University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston, the medical school at The University of Texas at Austin, the medical 13 school at The University of Texas Rio Grande Valley, the medical 14 education program of The University of Texas Health Science Center 15 16 at Tyler, the medical school at the Texas Tech University Health Sciences Center, the medical school at the Texas Tech University 17 Health Sciences Center at El Paso, the Baylor College of Medicine, 18 the college of osteopathic medicine at the University of North 19 20 Texas Health Science Center at Fort Worth, the school of osteopathic medicine at the University of the Incarnate Word, or 21 the medical school at the Texas A&M University Health Science 22 23 Center.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
