Subchapter B, Chapter 305, Government Code, is 5 6 amended by adding Section 305.029 to read as follows: 7 Sec. 305.029. EXPENDITURES FROM POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS (a) In this section, "political contribution," 8 RESTRICTED. "political committee," and "political expenditure" have the 9 meanings assigned by Section 251.001, Election Code. 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person 11 12 required to register under this chapter may not, before the second anniversary of the date the last term for which the person was 13 elected ends, knowingly make or authorize, from political 14 15 contributions accepted by the person as a candidate or officeholder, a political expenditure that is a political 16 contribution to a candidate, officeholder, or political committee. 17 SECTION 2. Section 305.029, Government Code, as added by 18 this Act, applies to an expenditure made on or after January 8, 19 2019, from funds accepted as a political contribution, regardless 20 21 of the date the funds were accepted. 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 8, 2019.
