## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to restrictions on lobbyist expenditures from certain

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 305, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 305.029 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 305.029. EXPENDITURES FROM POLITICAL CONTRIBUTIONS
- 8 RESTRICTED. (a) In this section, "political contribution" has the
- 9 meaning assigned by Section 251.001, Election Code.
- 10 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, a person
- 11 required to register under this chapter may not, before the second
- 12 anniversary of the date the last term for which the person was
- 13 <u>elected ends</u>, knowingly make or authorize an expenditure under this
- 14 chapter from political contributions accepted by the person as a
- 15 candidate or officeholder.
- SECTION 2. Section 305.029, Government Code, as added by
- 17 this Act, applies to a political contribution, political
- 18 expenditure, or lobbying expenditure made on or after January 8,
- 19 2019, from funds accepted as a political contribution, regardless
- 20 of the date the funds were accepted.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 8, 2019.
