CAREGIVER ASSISTANCE AGREEMENT. (a) The 8 9 department may, subject to the availability of funds, enter into a caregiver assistance agreement with a caregiver to provide monetary 10 assistance and additional support services to the caregiver. 11 The 12 monetary assistance and support services must be based on the caregiver's and child's needs, as determined by rules adopted by the 13 14 executive commissioner. (b) The department may agree to provide to a caregiver in an 15 16 agreement under this section any monetary assistance or additional support services that may be provided in a caregiver assistance 17 agreement under Section 264.755. 18 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and 19

19 SECTION 2. The executive commissioner of the Health and 20 Human Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to 21 implement Section 264.907, Family Code, as added by this Act, not 22 later than December 1, 2017.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
