11	(2) procedures for the commission to create, maintain,

15	(d) In creating a schedule of fees, the commission shall:
16	(1) use the reimbursement rate for the applicable
17	service under the Medicaid program; or
18	(2) modify that rate with a written justification for
19	the modification and after holding a public hearing on the issue of
20	the modification.
21	(e) Notwithstanding Subsection (c), a state supported
22	living center, based on negotiations between the center and a
23	managed care organization, as defined by Section 533.001,
24	Government Code may charge a fee for a service other than the fee

- 3 SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the executive
- 4 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
- 5 adopt the rules listing services a state supported living center
- 6 may provide under a contract and the procedures for the commission
- 7 to create the schedule of fees for those services, as required by
- 8 Section 161.080, Human Resources Code, as amended by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 11 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 13 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
