The commission shall issue the refund not later than the 30th day after the date the commission receives the 10 11 withdrawal request or denies the application.

SECTION 8. Section 2001.437, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows:

(i) The commission shall refund the fee for an initial or 14 15 renewal unit manager license if the applicant requests withdrawal 16 of the application before the license is issued or if the commission denies the application, except the commission may retain an amount 17 not to exceed the lesser of 50 percent of the license fee or \$150 to 18 defray any administrative cost incurred by the commission in 19 20 processing the application. The commission shall issue the refund not later than the 30th day after the date the commission receives 21 the withdrawal request or denies the application. 22

SECTION 9. Chapter 2001, Occupations Code, as amended by this Act, applies only to an application and fee submitted under that chapter on or after the effective date of this Act. An application and fee submitted before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the application and fee

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1 are submitted and the former law is continued in effect for that
2 purpose.

3 SECTION 10. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
