| 13 | another; and |
| 14 | (2) at the time of the entry or attempted entry, |
| 15 | asserts that the entry is authorized by or requested in connection |
| 16 | with eminent domain authority of an entity the person represents or |
| 17 | claims to represent that does not possess that eminent domain |
| 18 | authority. |
| 19 | (b) Proof of a culpable mental state under Subsection (a)(2) |
| 20 | is not required for a conviction of an offense under this section. |
| 21 | (c) An offense under this section is a state jail felony. |
