A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a review and report by the Railroad Commission of Texas regarding the oversight and enforcement of unpermitted discharges 3 of oil and gas waste or of other substances or materials associated 4 5 with certain operations or activities regulated by the commission. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act: 7 (1) "Commission" means the Railroad Commission of 8 9 Texas. (2) "Oil and gas waste" has the meaning assigned by 10 11 Section 91.1011, Natural Resources Code. 12 (b) Not later than September 1, 2018, the commission shall: 13 (1) review the commission's rules regarding the prevention, reporting, and documentation of unpermitted discharges 14 of oil and gas waste or of any other substance or material 15 16 associated with any operation or activity regulated by the commission under Section 91.101(a)(1), (2), or (3), Natural 17 Resources Code, and the enforcement of penalties for unpermitted 18 discharges of such waste, substances, or materials; and 19 20 (2) submit to the standing committees in the senate and house of representatives having primary jurisdiction over 21 22 natural resources a report that: 23 (A) details the commission's existing rules 24 regarding the prevention, reporting, and documentation of

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1 unpermitted discharges of oil and gas waste or of a substance or 2 material described by Subdivision (1) of this subsection and the 3 enforcement of penalties for unpermitted discharges of such waste, 4 substances, or materials;

5 (B) proposes changes to the rules that would 6 improve the commission's ability to prevent, document, and respond 7 to unpermitted discharges of oil and gas waste or of a substance or 8 material described by Subdivision (1) of this subsection and to 9 bring enforcement action against responsible parties; and

10 (C) proposes any legislative action necessary to 11 improve the commission's ability to prevent, document, and respond 12 to unpermitted discharges of oil and gas waste or of a substance or 13 material described by Subdivision (1) of this subsection and to 14 bring enforcement action against responsible parties.

15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 16 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 18 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 19 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
