6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
7	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 418, Government Code, is
8	amended by adding Section 418.053 to read as follows:
9	Sec. 418.053. STUDY REGARDING AGREEMENT WITH UNITED STATES
10	POSTAL SERVICE. (a) The division shall conduct a study to examine
11	the feasibility of establishing an agreement with the United States
12	Postal Service regarding the use of employees, resources, and
13	assets within the postal service during a state of disaster to:
14	(1) identify residential or commercial structures
15	that have been damaged;
16	(2) identify persons who reside in a damaged area and
17	the medical or physical needs of those persons;
18	(3) help assess the damage to neighborhoods or
19	communities; and
20	(4) assist in any other activity that the division
21	determines to be necessary in responding to the disaster.
22	(b) Not later than November 1, 2019, the division shall:
23	(1) complete the study;
24	(2) report the results of the study to the lieutenant

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- 1 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 2 standing committees of the house and the senate with jurisdiction
- 3 over public safety matters; and
- 4 (3) post the results of the study on the division's
- 5 <u>Internet website.</u>
- 6 (c) This section expires December 31, 2021.
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
