10	(1) [the] repair, maintenance, renovation, or
11	<pre>construction [replacement] of:</pre>
12	(A) freshwater fish hatcheries in this state;
13	<u>and</u>
14	(B) facilities supporting the management of and
15	research related to freshwater fisheries; [ər]
16	(2) [the] purchase of game fish that are stocked into
17	the public water of this state <u>;</u>
18	(3) restoration, enhancement, or management of
19	<pre>freshwater fish habitats;</pre>
20	(4) development of shoreline-based projects allowing
21	freshwater angler access; and
22	(5) administration and operation of freshwater fish
23	hatcheries in an amount not to exceed 20 percent of the average

annual net receipts in a state fiscal biennium.
