A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the expansion of applied workforce learning
3	opportunities in this state, including through the establishment of
4	the Texas Industry Internship Challenge.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 302, Labor Code, is
7	amended by adding Section 302.0028 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 302.0028. APPLIED WORKFORCE LEARNING OPPORTUNITIES;
9	TEXAS INDUSTRY INTERNSHIP CHALLENGE. (a) The commission, in
10	partnership with the Texas Education Agency and the Texas Higher
11	Education Coordinating Board, shall develop and implement
12	strategies to:
13	(1) significantly increase the number of, and
14	participation by students in, applied workforce learning
15	opportunities, including paid internships, externships, and
16	apprenticeships, offered by employers in high-demand industries
17	and occupations to students enrolled in high schools or public or
18	private institutions of higher education in this state, including
19	opportunities offered during the summer; and
20	(2) facilitate the uniform award by high schools and
21	public or private institutions of higher education of academic
22	credit to students for the successful completion of those

opportunities, where appropriate.

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(b) In carrying out its duties under Subsection (a), the

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- 1 commission shall establish the Texas Industry Internship Challenge
- 2 under which the commission develops and administers a centralized
- 3 electronic Internet portal through which, in a streamlined,
- 4 responsive, and user-friendly manner:
- 5 (1) employers may post information regarding applied
- 6 workforce learning opportunities described by Subsection (a); and
- 7 (2) students enrolled in high schools or public or
- 8 private institutions of higher education in this state may access
- 9 information regarding and apply for those opportunities.
- 10 (c) The commission, the commissioner of education, and the
- 11 Texas Higher Education Coordinating Board may adopt rules as
- 12 necessary for the administration of this section.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
