## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 30A.002(b), Education Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) A student is eligible to enroll full-time in courses
- 8 provided through the state virtual school network only if the
- 9 student:
- 10 (1) was enrolled in a public school in this state in
- 11 the preceding school year; or
- 12 (2) [has been placed in substitute care in this
- 13 state, regardless of whether the student was enrolled in a public
- 14 school in this state in the preceding school year:
- 15 (A) has been placed in substitute care in this
- 16 state; or
- 17 (B) is a dependent of a member of the United
- 18 States military who has been deployed or transferred to, or
- 19 otherwise currently resides in, this state.
- 20 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018
- 21 school year.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
