BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 841.0835, Health and Safety Code, is 7 amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 841.0835. COMMITTED PERSONS WITH SPECIAL NEEDS. (a) The Health and Human Services Commission, after coordination 9 [shall coordinate] with the office, shall [to] provide psychiatric 10 services, disability services, and housing for a committed person 11 with an intellectual or developmental disability, a mental illness, 12 or a physical disability that prevents the person from effectively 13 14 participating in the sex offender treatment program administered by 15 the office.

(b) For a committed person who the office has determined is 16 17 unable to effectively participate in the sex offender treatment program because the person's mental illness prevents the person 18 from understanding and internalizing the concepts presented by the 19 program's treatment material, the Health and Human Services 20 Commission shall provide inpatient mental health services until the 21 person is able to participate effectively in the sex offender 22 23 treatment program.
