4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 5, Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Chapter 561 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 561. PUBLIC INFORMATION INTERNET WEBSITE
8	Sec. 561.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
9	(1) "Governmental entity" means:
10	(A) a state agency in the executive, legislative,
11	or judicial branch of state government, including an institution of
12	higher education, as defined by Section 61.003, Education Code; or
13	(B) a political subdivision of this state.
14	(2) "Public information" means a public or legal
15	notice that a governmental entity is required to publish under a
16	statute or rule and any other information that a governmental
17	entity submits for publication on the public information Internet
18	website.
19	(3) "Public information Internet website" means the
20	official state Internet website developed and maintained by the
21	<pre>comptroller under this chapter.</pre>
22	Sec. 561.002. PUBLIC INFORMATION INTERNET WEBSITE. (a)
23	The comptroller shall develop and maintain an Internet website of
24	public information, including archived public information.

1	(b) The public information Internet website must be
2	designed to:
3	(1) allow a governmental entity to easily post public
4	information or the comptroller to post public information on
5	receipt of the information from the entity;
6	(2) allow the public to search and sort the public
7	information on the Internet website by:
8	(A) a specific municipality or county;
9	(B) a governmental entity name;
10	(C) the type of governmental entity;
11	(D) the date the public information is submitted;
12	(E) the date an event or deadline stated in the
13	<pre>public information occurred; and</pre>
14	(F) any additional criteria approved by the
15	<pre>comptroller;</pre>
16	(3) allow the public to search and view archived
17	public information posted on the Internet website;
18	(4) allow a person to subscribe to e-mail notices of
19	<pre>public information associated with a specific governmental entity;</pre>
20	(5) be easily accessible by the public 24 hours a day,
21	7 days a week, through the Texas.gov Internet website that includes
22	a direct link to the public information Internet website;
23	(6) have a unique and easy to remember Internet
24	website address; and
25	(7) have adequate systems for protection, backup, and
26	contingency planning to address power outages, systematic
27	failures, and electronic security.

- 1 (c) The comptroller shall develop a process for a governmental entity to access the public information Internet 2 website to post public information or modify information previously 3 posted by the entity or to submit the information or modified 4 5 information to the comptroller for posting on the Internet website. 6 Sec. 561.003. REQUIRED SUBMISSION OF PUBLIC INFORMATION.
- 7 Each governmental entity:
- 8 (1) shall submit for inclusion on the public information Internet website any public or legal notice the entity 9 10 is required to publish under statute or rule; and
- 11 (2) may submit any other public information the entity 12 elects to submit.
- Sec. 561.004. PUBLIC INFORMATION INTERNET WEBSITE DOES NOT 13 SATISFY PUBLICATION REQUIREMENT. A governmental entity's 14 15 submission of public information to the public information Internet 16 website does not satisfy a publication requirement under other law. 17 Submission of public information to the Internet website shall be
- made in addition to any other publication requirement. 18 19 Sec. 561.005. IMMUNITY FROM LIABILITY OR PENALTY. governmental entity that in good faith attempts to submit public 20 information to the public information Internet website and that 21 22 satisfies the publication requirements for that information under 23 other law is not subject to liability or other penalty for a failure 24 in posting the public information to the public information Internet website or in delivery of an e-mail notice of the posted 25 26 public information.
- 27 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date

- 1 of this Act, but not later than September 1, 2018:
- 2 (1) the comptroller of public accounts shall develop
- 3 the public information Internet website as required by Chapter 561,
- 4 Government Code, as added by this Act; and
- 5 (2) each governmental entity in this state shall begin
- 6 submitting public information to the public information Internet
- 7 website in the format and manner required by the comptroller and
- 8 Chapter 561, Government Code, as added by this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
