## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to notice of a property owner's rights relating to the
3	examination or survey of property by an entity with eminent domain
4	authority.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 402.031(c), Government Code, is amended
7	to read as follows:
8	(c) The statement must include:
9	(1) the title, "Landowner's Bill of Rights"; and
10	(2) a description of:
11	(A) the condemnation procedure provided by
12	Chapter 21, Property Code;
13	(B) the condemning entity's obligations to the
14	property owner, including the responsibility for any actual damages
15	arising from an examination or survey of the property; [and]
16	(C) the property owner's options during a
17	condemnation, including the property owner's right to $\underline{:}$
18	(i) seek to negotiate the terms of the
19	examination or survey of the property by the condemning entity; and
20	<u>(ii)</u> object to and appeal an amount of
21	damages awarded; and
22	(D) the condemning entity's right to sue for a
23	court order authorizing the examination or survey if the property
24	owner refuses to consent to the examination or survey.

- 1 SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 21, Property Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 21.01101 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 21.01101. SURVEY CONSENT FORM. If an entity with
- 4 eminent domain authority provides a form to an owner of real
- 5 property requesting the owner's consent to enter the property to
- 6 examine the property or conduct a survey of the property in
- 7 connection with the potential acquisition of the property for a
- 8 public use, the form must conspicuously state that:
- 9 (1) the owner has a right to seek to negotiate the
- 10 terms of the examination or survey of the property;
- 11 (2) the entity may sue for a court order authorizing
- 12 the entity to enter the property and conduct the examination or
- 13 survey if the owner refuses to consent to the examination or survey;
- 14 and
- 15 (3) the entity has the responsibility for any actual
- 16 damages arising from an examination or survey of the property.
- 17 SECTION 3. The office of the attorney general shall make the
- 18 landowner's bill of rights statement required by Section 402.031,
- 19 Government Code, as amended by this Act, available on the attorney
- 20 general's Internet website not later than January 1, 2018.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2018.
