5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 602, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Section 602.007 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 602.007. FILING OF OATH MADE BY CERTAIN JUDICIAL
9	OFFICERS AND JUDICIAL APPOINTEES. The oath made and signed
10	statement executed as required by Section 1, Article XVI, Texas
11	Constitution, by any of the following judicial officers and
12	judicial appointees shall be filed with the secretary of state:
13	(1) an officer appointed by the supreme court, the
14	court of criminal appeals, or the State Bar of Texas; and
15	(2) an associate judge appointed under Subchapter B or
16	C, Chapter 201, Family Code.

17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives

18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

21 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
