BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Chapter 602, Government Code, is amended by adding Section 602.007 to read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 602.007. FILING OF OATH MADE BY CERTAIN JUDICIAL OFFICERS AND JUDICIAL APPOINTEES. The oath made and signed statement executed as required by Section 1, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, by any of the following judicial officers and 1-25 1-26 1-27 1-28 judicial appointees shall be filed with the secretary of state: 1-29
