4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 102, Business & Commerce Code, is
6	amended by adding Subchapter C to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER C. NOTICE REQUIREMENTS ON PREMISES OF SEXUALLY ORIENTED
8	BUSINESSES
9	Sec. 102.101. POSTING OF CERTAIN SIGNS REQUIRED. (a) A
10	sexually oriented business shall post in each toilet stall of each
11	restroom on the premises a sign that directs a victim of human
12	trafficking to contact the National Human Trafficking Resource
13	Center. If a restroom does not have a toilet stall, the business
14	shall post the sign in a conspicuous location in the restroom.
15	(b) The attorney general by rule shall prescribe the design,
16	content, and manner of display of a sign required under this
17	section. The sign must:
18	(1) be in both English and Spanish; and
19	(2) include the telephone number and Internet website
20	of the National Human Trafficking Resource Center.
21	(c) The attorney general by rule may require the sign to:
22	(1) be in an additional language other than English or
23	Spanish; and
24	(2) include other information the attorney general

- 1 considers necessary and appropriate.
- Sec. 102.102. CRIMINAL PENALTY. (a) A person commits an
- 3 offense if the person:
- 4 (1) is an owner or operator of a sexually oriented
- 5 business; and
- 6 (2) fails to post the sign required by Section 102.101
- 7 <u>in compliance with that section and rules adopted under that</u>
- 8 section.
- 9 (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 10 If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this section that the
- 11 person has previously been convicted of an offense under this
- 12 section, the offense is a Class B misdemeanor.
- 13 SECTION 2. (a) The attorney general shall adopt rules to
- 14 implement Section 102.101, Business & Commerce Code, as added by
- 15 this Act, not later than September 1, 2018.
- 16 (b) Each sexually oriented business shall post the sign
- 17 required by Section 102.101, Business & Commerce Code, as added by
- 18 this Act, not later than March 1, 2019.
- 19 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 20 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
- 21 (b) Section 102.102, Business & Commerce Code, as added by
- 22 this Act, takes effect March 1, 2019.
