A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the collection and publication of the number of security personnel or commissioned peace officers employed by each 3 school district and assigned to each district campus. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. Section 37.081, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (i) to read as follows: 7 (i) Each school district shall report through the Public 8 9 Education Information Management System (PEIMS) the number of security personnel and commissioned peace officers employed by the 10 district and the number of security personnel and commissioned 11 peace officers assigned to each district campus. Each district 12 shall update the report as necessary to reflect any increase or 13 14 decrease in those numbers. The agency shall make the information reported for each district under this subsection available on the 15 16 agency's Internet website and update the information as necessary to accurately reflect the number of security personnel and 17 commissioned peace officers employed by each district and assigned 18 19 to district campuses.

20 SECTION 2. The board of trustees of each school district 21 shall report the information required by Section 37.081(i), 22 Education Code, as added by this Act, as soon as practicable after 23 the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
