- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 155, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 155.010 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 155.010. EXPEDITED LICENSING PROCESS FOR PHYSICIANS
- 8 SPECIALIZING IN PSYCHIATRY. (a) The board by rule shall create an
- 9 expedited licensing process for an applicant who:
- 10 (1) holds an unrestricted license to practice medicine
- 11 <u>issued by another state;</u>
- 12 (2) is board certified in psychiatry by the American
- 13 Board of Psychiatry and Neurology or the American Osteopathic Board
- 14 of Neurology and Psychiatry; and
- 15 (3) is not ineligible under Section 155.003(e).
- 16 (b) The expedited licensing process must include a
- 17 procedure for the board to screen applications under this subtitle
- 18 to determine whether an applicant would be eligible for the
- 19 expedited licensing process under this section.
- 20 <u>(c) The requirements for renewal of a registration permit</u>
- 21 for a license holder issued a license under this section may not be
- 22 more stringent than the requirements for a license holder issued a

- 2 SECTION 2. The Texas Medical Board shall create and
- 3 implement the expedited licensing process under Section 155.010,
- 4 Occupations Code, as added by this Act, not later than January 1,
- 5 2018.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
