3 (E) issuing other document (no return required)
4 (Sec. 118.121, Local Government Code) . . . \$1 for first page;
5 \$0.25 for each additional page; and

6 (3) court cost in civil cases in which the amount in 7 controversy exceeds \$4,999 but does not exceed \$10,000, other than 8 suits for delinquent taxes, to fund the county law library fund, if 9 authorized by the county commissioners court (Sec. 323.023, Local 10 <u>Government Code) . . . not to exceed \$35</u>.

SECTION 2. Section 323.023(a), Local Government Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) A sum set by the commissioners court not to exceed \$35
shall be taxed, collected, and paid as other costs in each civil
case filed in a county or district court <u>and in each civil case</u>
<u>filed in a justice court in which the amount in controversy exceeds</u>
<u>\$4,999 but does not exceed \$10,000</u> [, except suits for delinquent
<u>taxes. The county is not liable for the costs</u>].

19 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 20 to a civil action filed in a justice court on or after the effective 21 date of this Act. A civil action filed before that date is governed 22 by the law in effect on the date the action was filed, and the former 23 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
