Section 85.062, Election Code, is amended by 11 12 amending Subsections (a), (b), and (c) and adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: 13 14 (a) Except as provided by Subsection (d) [or (e)], one or more early voting polling places other than the main early voting 15 16 polling place may be established by: (1) the commissioners court, for an election in which 17 the county clerk is the early voting clerk; or 18 (2) the governing body of the political subdivision 19 served by the authority ordering the election, for an election in 20 21 which a person other than the county clerk is the early voting 22 clerk. 23 (b) A polling place established under this section may be located, subject to Subsection (d), at any place in the territory 24

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served by the early voting clerk and may be located in any 1 stationary structure as directed by the authority establishing the 2 3 branch office. The polling place may not be located in a movable structure [in the general election for state and county officers, 4 general primary election, or runoff primary election]. Ropes or 5 other suitable objects may be used at the polling place to ensure 6 compliance with Section 62.004. Persons who are not expressly 7 8 permitted by law to be in a polling place shall be excluded from the polling place to the extent practicable. 9

10 (c) In any election, the location of a polling place 11 established under this section shall be fixed at one place for the 12 duration of the period that voting is required to be conducted <u>for</u> 13 <u>that election</u> [at the polling place].

14 (h) If an authority holding an election for which the ballot 15 includes a proposition seeking voter approval of the issuance of 16 bonds or other debt establishes a polling place located in a movable 17 structure or location in violation of this section, the election 18 for approval of the proposition is invalid.

SECTION 3. Section 85.062(e), Election Code, is repealed.
SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
