1-17 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-18 AN ACT

1-19 relating to an exception from disclosure under the public
 1-20 information law for certain personal information of an applicant
 1-21 for an appointment by the governor.

1-22 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-23 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 552, Government Code, is
 1-24 amended by adding Section 552.158 to read as follows:

1-25 Sec. 552.158. EXCEPTION: CONFIDENTIALITY OF PERSONAL
 1-26 INFORMATION REGARDING APPLICANT FOR APPOINTMENT BY GOVERNOR. The
 1-27 following information obtained by the governor or senate in
 1-28 connection with an applicant for an appointment by the governor is
 1-29 excepted from the requirements of Section 552.021:

- 1-30 (1) the applicant's home address;
- 1-31 (2) the applicant's home telephone number; and
- 1-32 (3) the applicant's social security number.

1-33 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
 1-34 a request for information that is received by a governmental body or
 1-35 an officer for public information on or after the effective date of
 1-36 this Act. A request for information that was received before the
 1-37 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
 1-38 date the request was received, and the former law is continued in
 1-39 effect for that purpose.

1-40 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-41 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-42 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-43 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
