A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to requirements for new or increased municipal fees.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Chapter 102, Local Government Code, is amended
5	by adding Section 102.0001 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 102.0001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "fee" has the
7	meaning assigned by Section 109.001.
8	SECTION 2. Section 102.005, Local Government Code, is
9	amended by adding Subsection (b-1) to read as follows:
10	(b-1) A proposed budget that includes estimated revenue
11	from a new fee or the increase of an existing fee must contain a
12	cover page with the following statement in 18-point or larger type:
13	"This budget includes estimated revenue from the following new or
14	increased fees: (include a description of each new or increased
15	fee, the dollar amount of each new fee, and the dollar amount of and
16	percentage of increase of each increased fee)."
17	SECTION 3. Section 102.006(c), Local Government Code, is
18	amended to read as follows:
19	(c) The governing body shall provide for public notice of
20	the date, time, and location of the hearing. The notice must
21	include, in type of a size at least equal to the type used for other
22	items in the notice, any statement required to be included in the
23	proposed budget under Section 102.005(b) or (b-1).
24	SECTION 4. Section 102.0065(d), Local Government Code, is

1 amended to read as follows:

(d) Notice under this section must include, in type of a
size at least equal to the type used for other items in the notice,
any statement required to be included in the proposed budget under
Section 102.005(b) or (b-1).

6 SECTION 5. Section 102.007, Local Government Code, is 7 amended by adding Subsection (c-1) and amending Subsection (d) to 8 read as follows:

9 <u>(c-1) Adoption of a budget that includes estimated revenue</u> 10 from a new fee or the increase of an existing fee requires a 11 separate vote of the governing body to ratify the use of that 12 revenue. A vote under this subsection is in addition to and 13 separate from the vote to adopt the budget or a vote to adopt or 14 increase the fee.

15 (d) An adopted budget must contain a cover page that 16 includes:

17 (1) one of the following statements in 18-point or18 larger type that accurately describes the adopted budget:

(A) "This budget will raise more revenue from property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total dollar amount of increase), which is a (insert percentage increase) percent increase from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added to the roll).";

(B) "This budget will raise less revenue from
property taxes than last year's budget by an amount of (insert total

dollar amount of decrease), which is a (insert percentage decrease) percent decrease from last year's budget. The property tax revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax rate by the value of new property added to the roll)."; or

6 (C) "This budget will raise the same amount of 7 revenue from property taxes as last year's budget. The property tax 8 revenue to be raised from new property added to the tax roll this 9 year is (insert amount computed by multiplying the proposed tax 10 rate by the value of new property added to the roll).";

(2) <u>if applicable, the following statement in 18-point</u> or larger type: "This budget includes estimated revenue from the following new or increased fees: (include a description of each new or increased fee, the dollar amount of each new fee, and the dollar amount of and percentage of increase of each increased fee).";

16 (3) the record vote of each member of the governing 17 body by name voting on the adoption of the budget;

18 <u>(4)</u> [(3)] the municipal property tax rates for the 19 preceding fiscal year, and each municipal property tax rate that 20 has been adopted or calculated for the current fiscal year, 21 including:

22 (A) the property tax rate; the effective tax rate; 23 (B) 24 (C) the effective maintenance and operations tax 25 rate; the rollback tax rate; and 26 (D) 27 (E) the debt rate; and

1 (5) [(4)] the total amount of municipal debt
2 obligations.

3 SECTION 6. Section 102.008, Local Government Code, is
4 amended to read as follows:

Sec. 102.008. APPROVED BUDGET FILED WITH MUNICIPAL CLERK:
POSTING ON INTERNET. (a) On final approval of the budget by the
governing body of the municipality, the governing body shall:

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(1) file the budget with the municipal clerk; and

9 (2) if the municipality maintains an Internet website, 10 take action to ensure that:

(A) a copy of the budget, including the coverpage, is posted on the website; and

(B) the record vote described by Section 14 <u>102.007(d)(3)</u> [<u>102.007(d)(2)</u>] is posted on the website at least 15 until the first anniversary of the date the budget is adopted.

16 (b) The governing body shall take action to ensure that the 17 cover page of the budget is amended to include the property tax rates required by Section 102.007(d)(4) [102.007(d)(3)] for the 18 current fiscal year if the rates are not included on the cover page 19 20 when the budget is filed with the municipal clerk. The governing body shall file an amended cover page with the municipal clerk and 21 22 take action to ensure that the amended cover page is posted on the municipality's website. 23

24 SECTION 7. Subtitle A, Title 4, Local Government Code, is 25 amended by adding Chapter 109 to read as follows:

26CHAPTER 109. NEW OR INCREASED MUNICIPAL FEES27Sec. 109.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "fee" means any

fee, charge, assessment, or similar payment required by a 1 municipality for a privilege, service, authorization, permit, 2 license, registration, certification, filing, or other municipal 3 4 action or approval. 5 Sec. 109.002. E-MAIL NOTIFICATION SERVICE. (a) This section does not apply to a municipality located primarily in a 6 7 county with a population of less than 30,000. 8 (b) Each municipality shall establish and maintain an 9 e-mail notification service to which any person may electronically subscribe to receive information regarding new or increased 10 11 municipal fees. (c) The e-mail notification service must: 12 13 (1) allow a subscriber to request notification of 14 each: 15 (A) new fee proposed to be adopted by the 16 municipality; 17 (B) existing fee proposed to be increased by the 18 municipality; 19 (C) proposed budget of the municipality that 20 includes use of revenue from a fee described by Paragraph (A) or (B); 21 22 (D) adopted budget of the municipality that includes use of revenue from a fee described by Paragraph (A) or 23 24 (B); or 25 (E) public hearing scheduled to be held at which a fee or budget described by Paragraphs (A)-(D) is scheduled to be 26 27 discussed;

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1	(2) include a link in the notification to any web page
2	maintained by the municipality on which the fee or budget may be
3	viewed; and
4	(3) notify the subscriber by e-mail not later than the
5	day:
6	(A) the municipality provides public notice of a
7	public hearing at which a proposed new or increased fee or a
8	proposed budget is scheduled to be discussed, for notification of a
9	public hearing for a proposed fee or budget;
10	(B) the budget officer files a proposed budget
11	with the municipal clerk as required by Section 102.005, for
12	notification of a proposed budget; or
13	(C) the governing body files an adopted budget
14	with the municipal clerk as required by Section 102.008, for
15	notification of an adopted budget.
16	Sec. 109.003. PUBLIC HEARING ON NEW OR INCREASED FEE.
17	(a) The governing body of a municipality may not adopt a new fee or
18	the increase of an existing fee unless the governing body holds a
19	public hearing at which members of the public are given the
20	opportunity to be heard.
21	(b) The hearing required by Subsection (a) must be held not
22	earlier than the 60th day or later than the 30th day before the date
23	the governing body adopts the new fee or the increase of the
24	existing fee.
25	SECTION 8. The changes in law made by Sections 102.005,
26	102.006, 102.0065, 102.007, and 102.008, Local Government Code, as
27	amended by this Act, apply only to a proposed or adopted budget for

1 a fiscal year beginning on or after January 1, 2018.

2 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
