- 1 (b) The special commissioners may admit evidence on the 2 price paid for pipeline or power line rights-of-way in privately 3 negotiated transactions made in the absence of a potential, actual,
- 4 or threatened condemnation.
- 5 SECTION 3. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this section, Sections 21.0113 and 21.041, Property Code, as amended by 6 this Act, apply only to the acquisition of real property in 7 connection with an initial offer made under Section 21.0113, 8 Property Code, on or after the effective date of this Act. 9 acquisition of real property in connection with an initial offer 10 made under Section 21.0113, Property Code, before the effective 11 12 date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the acquisition immediately before the effective date of this Act, and 13 14 that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- (b) Section 21.041(b), Property Code, as added by this Act, applies only to an eminent domain proceeding commenced on or after the effective date of this Act. An eminent domain proceeding commenced before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law applicable to the proceeding immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
