S.B. No. 744

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a tree planting credit to offset tree mitigation fees imposed by a municipality. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 212, Local Government Code, is amended by adding Section 212.905 to read as follows: 6 Sec. 212.905. TREE MITIGATION FEE CREDIT FOR PLANTED TREES. 7 (a) A municipality that imposes a tree mitigation fee for tree 8 9 removal that is necessary for development or construction on a person's property that is located in the municipality must allow 10 that person to apply for a credit for tree planting under this 11 section to offset the amount of the fee. 12 (b) An application for a credit under Subsection (a) must be 13 14 in the form and manner prescribed by the municipality. The tree must be planted on property located in the municipality either 15 16 owned by the person or mutually agreed upon by the municipality and 17 the person. 18 (c) The amount of a credit provided to a person under this section must be applied in the same manner as the tree mitigation 19 fee assessed against the person. If the amount of the tree 20 mitigation fee is based on the size of the tree being removed, the 21 amount of the credit must be based on at least 60 percent of the 22 23 projected size of the planted tree at full maturity. 24 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to

1 a tree mitigation fee assessed by a municipality on or after the 2 effective date of this Act.

3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
