- 15 SECTION 2. Subchapter C, Chapter 436, Government Code, is
- 16 amended by adding Section 436.1051 to read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 436.1051. MILITARY BASE REALIGNMENT AND CLOSURE TASK
- 18 FORCE; PRESERVATION OF INFORMATION. (a) On the abolishment of the
- 19 military base realignment and closure task force, the task force
- 20 shall transfer all information written, produced, collected,
- 21 assembled, or maintained by or for the task force to the commission
- 22 and the commission shall maintain the information.
- 23 (b) Any information transferred to the commission under
- 24 Subsection (a) is public information subject to disclosure under
