5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 493, Government Code, is amended by
7	adding Section 493.0152 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 493.0152. ACCOUNTING FOR COSTS OF ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION.
9	(a) Not later than the 30th day before the first day of each regular
10	legislative session, the department shall issue to the speaker of
11	the house of representatives, the lieutenant governor, the
12	governor, and the attorney general a report of the financial costs
13	to the department incurred during the preceding two-year period

(b) The report must include a separate accounting for the 16 costs to the department incurred in specific categories of spending 17

that resulted from the presence in this state of persons who are not

- as determined by the department. 19 (c) On request of the department, the comptroller shall
- assist the department in preparing the report. 20

lawfully present in the United States.

21 SECTION 2. This state recognizes that 22 responsibility of the federal government to maintain the security of the national border to prevent unlawful entry of persons and 23 finds that the federal government should reimburse this state for 24

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- 1 expenditures by the Texas Department of Criminal Justice made
- 2 necessary by the presence of persons in this state who are not
- 3 lawfully present in the United States.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
