Section 46.15, Penal Code, is amended by adding 6 Subsection (h) to read as follows: 7 (h) The provisions of Sections 46.02 and 46.03 prohibiting 8 9 the possession or carrying of a club do not apply to a code enforcement officer who: 10 11 (1) holds a certificate of registration issued under 12 Chapter 1952, Occupations Code; and 13 (2) possesses or carries an instrument used 14 specifically for deterring the bite of an animal while the officer 15 is: 16 (A) performing official duties; or (B) traveling to or from a place of duty. 17 18 SECTION 2. Section 1952.051, Occupations Code, as effective September 1, 2017, is amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as 19 follows: 20 21 (c) The education requirements adopted under Subsection (b) 22 must include education regarding the principles and procedures to 23 be followed when possessing or carrying an instrument used specifically for deterring the bite of an animal. 24

SECTION 3. Section 1952.1051, Occupations Code, as
effective September 1, 2017, is amended to read as follows:

3 Sec. 1952.1051. CONTINUING EDUCATION. The commission by 4 rule shall prescribe continuing education requirements for code 5 enforcement officers and code enforcement officers in training 6 that:

7 (1)establish the number of hours of continuing 8 education required for renewal of a certificate of registration; 9 (2) establish an approved curriculum that includes material regarding changes in applicable law and the principles and 10 procedures to be followed when possessing or carrying an instrument 11 used specifically for deterring the bite of an animal; and 12 (3) provide that the approved curriculum may be taught 13 14 by suitable public agencies and by private entities approved by the

15 department.
