## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the indigent status of a person for the purposes of the
- 3 driver responsibility program.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 708.158(a), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The department shall waive all surcharges assessed
- 8 under this chapter for a person who is indigent. For the purposes
- 9 of this section, a person is considered to be indigent if the person
- 10 provides the evidence described by Subsection (b) to the court. The
- 11 court on its own motion may inquire whether the person would like to
- 12 <u>submit evidence to establish the person's indigent status.</u>
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act to Section
- 14 708.158, Transportation Code, applies only to a trial that begins
- 15 on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of whether
- 16 the offense occurred before, on, or after the effective date of this
- 17 Act. The state is not required to refund a surcharge collected
- 18 before the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
