- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 662, Government Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 662.066 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 662.066. FALLEN LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER DAY. (a) July
- 8 7 is Fallen Law Enforcement Officer Day in recognition of the
- 9 ultimate sacrifice made by Texas law enforcement officers killed in
- 10 the line of duty.
- 11 (b) Fallen Law Enforcement Officer Day shall be regularly
- 12 observed by appropriate ceremonies.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
