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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 61.0667 to read as follows: 8
- Sec. 61.0667. STUDY ON BEST PRACTICES IN DUAL CREDIT AND 9
- CREDIT TRANSFER. (a) The board shall conduct a study to identify 10
- best practices in ensuring that dual credit courses provided by an 11
- institution of higher education and courses transferred to an 12
- institution of higher education for course credit apply toward a 13
- 14 degree program at the institution.
- (b) The study must: 15
- 16 (1) evaluate existing articulation agreements under
- which institutions of higher education provide dual credit courses 17
- to school district students or that govern the transfer of course 18
- 19 credit between institutions of higher education; and
- (2) identify those institutions of higher education 20
- that are implementing the best practices identified under 21
- 22 Subsection (a).
- 23 (c) On request, an institution of higher education shall
- provide information to the board as necessary for the board to 24

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- 1 perform its duties under this section.
- 2 (d) Not later than September 1, 2018, the board shall submit
- 3 to the legislature the results of its study under this section and
- 4 recommendations for legislative or other action.
- 5 <u>(e) This section expires September 1, 2019.</u>
- 6 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- $7\,$ a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
