- 2 relating to the board of directors of the Agua Special Utility
- 3 District.

- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- SECTION 1. Section 7201.052, Special District Local Laws 5
- Code, is amended by amending Subsections (a), (b), (c), and (l) and 6
- 7 adding Subsection (m) to read as follows:
- Except as provided by Subsection (1), the district shall 8
- be governed by a board of seven directors, elected as follows: 9
- (1) one director elected by the voters of the part of 10
- 11 the City of Mission inside the district to represent that part of
- 12 the city;
- 13 (2) one director elected by the voters of the City of
- 14 Palmview to represent that city;
- (3) one director elected by the voters of the City of 15
- 16 Penitas to represent that city;
- (4) one director elected by the voters of the City of 17
- Sullivan City to represent that city; [and] 18
- one director elected by the voters of the City of 19
- 20 La Joya to represent that city; and
- 21 (6) two [three] directors elected at-large to numbered
- positions on the board by the district voters who do not reside in 22
- 23 any of the municipalities listed in Subdivisions (1)-(5) $[\frac{(1)-(4)}{(1)}]$
- to represent the part of the district that is not included in those 24

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- 1 municipalities, unless the number of at-large directors is
- 2 increased under Subsection (1).
- 3 (b) A candidate for one of the numbered director positions:
- 4 (1) must reside in the part of the service area of the
- 5 district that is not included in any of the municipalities listed in
- 6 Subsections (a)(1)-(5) $[\frac{(a)(1)-(4)}{(a)(1)-(4)}]$; and
- 7 (2) must be eligible to hold office under Section
- 8 141.001, Election Code.
- 9 (c) A candidate for one of the director positions
- 10 representing a municipality listed in Subsection (a)(1), (2), (3),
- 11 [or] (4), or (5):
- 12 (1) must reside in the municipality the candidate
- 13 seeks to represent; and
- 14 (2) must be eligible to hold office under Section
- 15 141.001, Election Code.
- 16 (1) If, before the expiration of the term of a director
- 17 elected to represent a municipality under Subsection (a)(1), (2),
- 18 (3), $[\frac{or}{a}]$ (4), $\frac{or}{a}$ (5), the district determines that all of the
- 19 incorporated territory of the municipality is outside the
- 20 boundaries of the district, the position immediately becomes an
- 21 at-large numbered position to be filled at the next general
- 22 election of the district in accordance with Subsections (a)(6)
- 23 $[\frac{(a)(5)}{}]$ and (b).
- 24 (m) If a director is an employee of another taxing entity
- 25 within the district, the board may not employ as an employee, as a
- 26 consultant, or on a contract basis:
- 27 (1) an elected official of the other taxing entity

- 1 that employs the director; or
- 2 (2) a person related to that elected official in the
- 3 third degree of consanguinity or affinity as determined under
- 4 Chapter 573, Government Code.
- 5 SECTION 2. (a) The position of director of the Agua Special
- 6 Utility District elected at-large for a term that expires in 2018
- 7 becomes the position for the director elected from the City of La
- 8 Joya on the election date in 2018 when the district elects new
- 9 directors. The director of the Agua Special Utility District
- 10 elected at-large to a term that expires in 2018 shall serve until a
- 11 director elected from the City of La Joya has qualified following
- 12 the director's election held in 2018.
- 13 (b) This section expires September 1, 2020.
- 14 SECTION 3. (a) The legal notice of the intention to
- 15 introduce this Act, setting forth the general substance of this
- 16 Act, has been published as provided by law, and the notice and a
- 17 copy of this Act have been furnished to all persons, agencies,
- 18 officials, or entities to which they are required to be furnished
- 19 under Section 59, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, and Chapter 313,
- 20 Government Code.
- 21 (b) The governor, one of the required recipients, has
- 22 submitted the notice and Act to the Texas Commission on
- 23 Environmental Quality.
- 24 (c) The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality has filed
- 25 its recommendations relating to this Act with the governor, the
- 26 lieutenant governor, and the speaker of the house of
- 27 representatives within the required time.

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- 1 (d) All requirements of the constitution and laws of this
- 2 state and the rules and procedures of the legislature with respect
- 3 to the notice, introduction, and passage of this Act are fulfilled
- 4 and accomplished.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
