7	Sec. 32.0249. MENTAL HEALTH SCREENINGS IN TEXAS HEALTH
8	STEPS PROGRAM. The executive commissioner, in the rules governing
9	the Texas Health Steps program, shall:
10	(1) require that at least one mental health screening
11	be provided under the program using one or more validated,
12	standardized mental health screening tools to each recipient who is
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- at least 12 years of age but younger than 19 years of age; 13
- 14 (2) require the mental health screening described in
- Subdivision (1) to be conducted during a recipient's annual medical 15
- 16 exam;
- 17 (3) allow a provider to conduct a mental health
- 18 screening using one or more validated, standardized mental health
- screening tools during each annual medical exam of a recipient 19
- described by Subdivision (1); and 20
- 21 (4) only allow a provider to be reimbursed for
- conducting one mental health screening using one or more validated, 22
- standardized mental health screening tools during each annual 23
- medical exam of a recipient described by Subdivision (1). 24

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- 1 SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act
- 2 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a
- 3 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision,
- 4 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or
- 5 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the
- 6 waiver or authorization is granted.
- 7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
