- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 659.012, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (a) Notwithstanding Section 659.011 and except as provided
- 9 by Subsection (a-1):
- 10 (1) a judge of a district court is entitled to an
- 11 annual salary from the state of at least \$125,000, except that the
- 12 combined salary of a district judge from state and county sources,
- 13 including compensation for any extrajudicial services performed on
- 14 behalf of the county, may not exceed the amount that is \$5,000 less
- 15 than the salary provided for a justice of a court of appeals other
- 16 than a chief justice;
- 17 (2) a justice of a court of appeals other than the
- 18 chief justice is entitled to an annual salary from the state that is
- 19 equal to 110 percent of the salary of a district judge, except that
- 20 the combined salary of a justice of the court of appeals other than
- 21 the chief justice from all state and county sources, including
- 22 compensation for any extrajudicial services performed on behalf of
- 23 the county, may not exceed the amount that is \$5,000 less than the
- 24 salary provided for a justice of the supreme court;

- 1 (3) a justice of the supreme court other than the chief
- 2 justice or a judge of the court of criminal appeals other than the
- 3 presiding judge is entitled to an annual salary from the state that
- 4 is equal to 120 percent of the salary of a district judge; and
- 5 (4) the chief justice or presiding judge of an
- 6 appellate court is entitled to an annual salary from the state that
- 7 is \$2,500 more than the salary provided for the other justices or
- 8 judges of the court, except that the combined salary of the chief
