A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

relating to the sequencing of required English language arts 1-21 1-22 1-23 courses and mathematics courses in schools.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. Section 28.025(b-2), Education Code, as amended by Chapter 211 (H.B. 5), Acts of the 83rd Legislature, Regular Session, 2013, is amended to read as follows: 1-25 1-26

(b-2) In adopting rules under Subsection (b-1), the State Board of Education shall provide for a student to comply with the curriculum requirements for an advanced English course under 1-27 1-28 1-29 Subsection (b-1)(1) [taken after successful completion of English 1-30 I, English II, and English III], for an advanced mathematics course 1-31 1-32 under Subsection (b-1)(2) [taken after the successful completion of Algebra I and geometry], and for any advanced science course under Subsection (b-1)(3) by successfully completing a course in the 1-33 1-34 appropriate content area that has been approved as an advanced 1-35 course by board rule or that is offered as an advanced course for credit without board approval as provided by Section 28.002(g-1). 1-36 1-37

1-38 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2017-2018 1-39 school year.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 1-40 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 1-41 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 1-42 1-43 1-44 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
