## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT 2 relating to state funding for baccalaureate degree programs offered at certain public junior colleges. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 130.0012(b-1), Education Code, amended to read as follows: 6 (b-1) The coordinating board shall <u>authorize</u> [establish a 7 pilot project to examine the feasibility and effectiveness of 8 9 authorizing] baccalaureate degree programs in the field of dental hygiene at a public junior college that offers a degree program in 10 11 that field, has a main campus located in the county seat of a county 12 with a population greater than 200,000, and includes territory in at least six public school districts located in two counties. 13 14 Subsection (g) applies [does not apply] to junior-level and senior-level courses offered under this subsection. [In its 15 16 recommendations to the legislature relating to state funding for public junior colleges, the coordinating board shall recommend that 17 junior-level and senior-level courses offered under this 18 subsection by a public junior college receive the same state 19 support as other courses offered by the public junior college. 20 21 SECTION 2. Sections 130.0012(b-2) and (b-3), Education 22 Code, are repealed. 23 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section

- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
