| 15 | Sec. 51.502. OCCUPATIONAL LICENSING DATABASE. (a) The |
| 16 | department shall create and make accessible on an Internet website |
| 17 | maintained by the department an occupational licensing database as |

| 19 | (b) The database must include with respect to each license |
| 20 | required by a licensing authority: |
| 21 | (1) the purpose for which the license is issued; |
| 22 | (2) the requirements, including the types and number |

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(3) the estimated financial cost to an applicant in 1 2 obtaining the license, including the cost of fulfilling education and training requirements and application fees; and 3 4 (4) the number of license holders. 5 (c) At least annually, the department shall update the 6 information in the database for each license, as appropriate. 7 (d) To the extent possible, the department shall present information in the database in a manner that is searchable and 8 intuitive to users. 9 10 (e) The department may not charge a fee to the public to 11 access the database. Sec. 51.503. REPORTING OF LICENSING INFORMATION 12 ТО DEPARTMENT. Not later than February 1 of each year, a licensing 13 authority shall submit to the department, in a form and in the 14 15 manner prescribed by the department, a report containing the information described by Section 51.502(b) and other information 16 17 specified by the department for the purpose of providing the department with information to maintain the occupational licensing 18 19 database under Section 51.502. SECTION 2. Not later than September 1, 2018, the Texas 20 Department of Licensing and Regulation shall make accessible to the 21 public the occupational licensing database required by Section 22 51.502, Occupations Code, as added by this Act. 23

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SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
