A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the membership of the Texas Racing Commission. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Section 2.02(a), Texas Racing Act (Article 179e, 5 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows: (a) 6 The commission consists of eight [seven] members 7 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate and [two ex officio members who shall have the right to vote. The ex 8 officio members are: 9 [(1)] the chairman of the Public Safety Commission or 10 11 a member of the Public Safety Commission designated by the chairman 12 of the Public Safety Commission, who shall serve as an ex officio member with the right to vote [; and 13 14 [(2) the comptroller of public comptroller's designee]. 15 SECTION 2. Section 2.05(a), Texas Racing Act (Article 179e, 16 Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), is amended to read as follows: 17 18 <u>Six</u> [Five] of the appointed members of the commission (a) must be representatives of the general public and have general 19 knowledge of business or agribusiness. At least one of those 20 21 appointed members may be a veterinarian, and being licensed as a 22 veterinarian satisfies the requirement that the person have general 23 knowledge of business or agribusiness. One additional appointed member must have special knowledge or experience related to 24

1 greyhound racing and one additional appointed member must have
2 special knowledge or experience related to horse racing. A person
3 is not eligible for appointment as a member of the commission if the
4 person or the person's spouse:

5 (1) is licensed by the commission, except as a 6 commissioner;

7 (2) is employed by the commission or participates in 8 the management of a business entity or other organization regulated 9 by the commission or receiving funds from or through the 10 commission;

(3) owns or controls, directly or indirectly, more than a 10 percent interest in a business entity or other organization regulated by the commission or receiving funds from or through the commission; or

(4) uses or receives a substantial amount of tangible
goods, services, or funds from or through the commission, other
than compensation or reimbursement authorized by law for commission
membership, attendance, or expenses.

19 SECTION 3. As soon as practicable after the effective date 20 of this Act, the governor shall appoint one additional member to the 21 Texas Racing Commission to comply with Section 2.02(a), Texas 22 Racing Act (Article 179e, Vernon's Texas Civil Statutes), as 23 amended by this Act. The additional member appointed in accordance 24 with Section 2.02(a) shall serve a term expiring February 1, 2019.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.

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
