- 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 330, Local Government Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 330.002 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 330.002. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY OF CERTAIN COUNTIES
- 8 TO IMPROVE OR REDEVELOP CERTAIN SPORTS FACILITIES. (a) In this
- 9 <u>section:</u>
- 10 (1) "County revenue" includes revenue from property
- 11 taxes, hotel occupancy taxes, fees, and fines.
- 12 (2) "Obsolete sports facility" means a multipurpose
- 13 arena, coliseum, or stadium designed to be used in part as a venue
- 14 for professional sports events and that opened to the public before
- 15 1966.
- 16 (b) This section applies only to a county with a population
- 17 of 3.3 million or more.
- 18 (c) A county may not fund, in whole or in part, the
- 19 improvement or redevelopment of an obsolete sports facility with
- 20 county revenue or debt if the improvement or redevelopment will
- 21 cost \$10 million or more, unless the funding is approved by the
- 22 voters of the county at an election held for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
