4	SECTION 1. Title 6, Natural Resources Code, is amended by
5	adding Chapter 154 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 154. OWNERSHIP AND LOCAL REGULATION OF TREES AND TIMBER
7	Sec. 154.001. DEFINITIONS. In this chapter:
8	(1) "Governmental entity" means a political
9	subdivision of the state, including:
10	(A) a municipality; and
11	(B) a county.
12	(2) "Removal of a tree" means the harvesting, cutting,
13	or destruction of a tree, including the damaging of a tree in a way
14	that will cause the death of the tree on or before the first
15	anniversary of the date of the damage, as determined by a
16	governmental entity.
17	Sec. 154.002. OWNERSHIP OF TREES AND TIMBER. A landowner
18	owns all trees and timber located on the landowner's land as a part
19	of the real property until cut or otherwise removed from the land,
20	unless otherwise provided by a contract, bill of sale, deed,
21	mortgage, deed of trust, or other legally binding document.
22	Sec. 154.003. LOCAL REGULATION OF TREES AND TIMBER. (a) A
23	governmental entity may not prohibit a landowner from trimming or
24	removing trees or timber located on the landowner's land.

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1	(b) Notwithstanding any other law, a municipality may not
2	regulate the trimming or removal of trees or timber in the
3	extraterritorial jurisdiction of the municipality.
4	(c) This section does not affect the authority of a county
5	to regulate the cutting of trees under Section 240.909, Local
6	Government Code.
7	(d) This section does not apply to the facilities or
8	operations of an electric utility or a transmission and
9	distribution utility, as those terms are defined by Section 31.002,
10	Utilities Code.
11	Sec. 154.004. APPLICABILITY TO TREE TRIMMING OR REMOVAL IN
12	UTILITY RIGHT-OF-WAY. This chapter does not apply to the trimming
13	or removal of a tree in the easement or right-of-way of a pipeline
14	<u>or utility line.</u>
15	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
