- 2 relating to the definition of the least restrictive environment for

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 263.001(a), Family Code, is amended by
- 6 amending Subdivision (3-a) and adding Subdivision (3-b) to read as
- 7 follows:

- 8 (3-a) "Least restrictive environment" means a
- 9 placement for a child that, in comparison to all other available
- 10 placements:
- 11 (A) is the closest in geographic proximity to the
- 12 child's home; and
- 13 (B) is the most able to meet the identified needs
- 14 of the child.
- 15 (3-b) "Physician assistant" has the meaning assigned
- 16 by Section 157.051, Occupations Code.
- SECTION 2. Section 263.001, Family Code, is amended by
- 18 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) With respect to a child designated by the department as
- 20 <u>a child who needs basic or moderate services, the least restrictive</u>
- 21 environment requires placement in a foster home or a general
- 22 residential operation operating as a cottage home.
- SECTION 3. Section 264.001, Family Code, is amended by
- 24 adding Subdivision (3-a) to read as follows:

- 1 (3-a) "Least restrictive environment" means a

- 8 SECTION 4. Section 264.107, Family Code, is amended by
- 9 adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- 10 (c) The department shall place a child designated by the
- 11 department as a child who needs basic or moderate services in the
- 12 <u>least restrictive environment necessary to meet the child's needs.</u>
- 13 Placement of a child in the least restrictive environment requires
- 14 placement in a foster home or a general residential operation
- 15 operating as a cottage home.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
