## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the reimbursement of certain providers under the
3	Medicaid program for the provision of telehealth services.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 531, Government Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 531.02171 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 531.02171. REIMBURSEMENT FOR CERTAIN TELEHEALTH
8	SERVICES. (a) In this section, "health professional" means an
9	individual who is:
10	(1) licensed, registered, certified, or otherwise
11	authorized by this state to practice as a social worker,
12	occupational therapist, or speech-language pathologist;
13	(2) a licensed professional counselor; or
14	(3) a licensed specialist in school psychology.
15	(b) The commission shall ensure that Medicaid reimbursement
16	is provided to a school district or open-enrollment charter school
17	for telehealth services provided through the school district or
18	charter school by a health professional, even if the health
19	professional is not the patient's primary care provider, if:
20	(1) the school district or charter school is an
21	authorized health care provider under Medicaid; and
22	(2) the parent or legal guardian of the patient
23	provides consent before the service is provided.
24	SECTION 2. If before implementing any provision of this Act

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1 a state agency determines that a waiver or authorization from a 2 federal agency is necessary for implementation of that provision, 3 the agency affected by the provision shall request the waiver or 4 authorization and may delay implementing that provision until the 5 waiver or authorization is granted.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
