5	SECTION 1. Title 16, Election Code, is amended by adding
6	Chapter 279 to read as follows:
7	CHAPTER 279. ENFRANCHISEMENT OF PERSONS CONFINED IN JAIL
8	Sec. 279.001. APPLICABILITY. This chapter applies to a
9	person confined in a city or county jail.
10	Sec. 279.002. NOTICE OF VOTING RIGHTS. (a) The secretary
11	of state shall prescribe a written notice to be provided to each
12	person confined in a city or county jail that states:
13	(1) that persons eligible to vote may vote an absented
14	<pre>ballot from jail;</pre>
15	(2) the upcoming election dates; and
16	(3) the voter registration deadlines and absented
17	ballot request deadlines applicable to the upcoming elections.

- (b) The notice must be printed in English, Spanish,

Vietnamese, and Mandarin. On the request of a person who does not

- speak one of these languages, a translation of the notice into the 20
- 21 person's primary language must be provided.
- (c) The secretary of state shall adopt rules relating to the 22
- provision of the notice prescribed under this section to ensure 23
- 24 that the notice is visible and accessible to persons confined in the

- 2 Sec. 279.003. VOTING MATERIALS. (a) The officially
- 3 prescribed application form for registration by mail shall be made
- 4 available to persons confined in jail who are eligible to register
- 5 to vote. The officially prescribed application form for an early
- 6 voting ballot shall be made available to persons confined in jail
- 7 who are qualified voters.
- 8 (b) The authority in charge of the jail shall facilitate the
- 9 proper delivery of voter registration applications, applications
- 10 for ballots to be voted by mail, and marked ballots to eligible
- 11 persons and is responsible for the payment of any required postage.
- 12 <u>(c) The secretary of state may adopt any rules necessary to</u>
- 13 implement this section.
- 14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
