4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 54.201 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 54.201. CERTAIN FINANCIAL AID ELIGIBILITY INFORMATION
8	REQUIRED. (a) Notwithstanding any other law and subject to
9	Subsection (b), to qualify for an exemption, waiver, or other
10	benefit authorized under this subchapter for enrollment at ar
11	institution of higher education during an academic year, a person
12	must:
13	(1) complete a free application for federal student
14	aid (FAFSA) for that academic year and:
15	(A) submit the person's FAFSA student aid report
16	to the institution; or
17	(B) designate the institution as a preferred
18	institution to receive the report from the United States Department
19	of Education; or

- 20 (2) if the person is not eligible to receive federal
- 21 student aid, complete and submit to the institution the Texas
- 22 Application for State Financial Aid (TASFA) or a similar
- 23 <u>application for state student financial assistance.</u>
- (b) Subsection (a) does not apply to a person who receives a

- 1 waiver under Section 54.216.
- 2 SECTION 2. Section 54.341(h), Education Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (h) The governing board of each institution of higher
- 5 education shall electronically report to the Texas Higher Education
- 6 <u>Coordinating Board</u> [Veterans Commission] the information required
- 7 by Section 61.0516 [434.00791, Government Code,] relating to each
- 8 individual receiving an exemption from fees and charges under
- 9 Subsection (a), (a-2), (b), or (k). The institution shall report
- 10 the information not later than January 31 of each year for the fall
- 11 semester, June 30 of each year for the spring semester, and
- 12 September 30 of each year for the summer session.
- 13 SECTION 3. Section 434.00791, Government Code, is
- 14 transferred to Subchapter C, Chapter 61, Education Code,
- 15 redesignated as Section 61.0516, Education Code, and amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- Sec. $\underline{61.0516}$ [$\underline{434.00791}$]. ELECTRONIC SYSTEM TO MONITOR
- 18 TUITION EXEMPTIONS FOR VETERANS AND <u>DEPENDENTS</u> [FAMILY MEMBERS].
- 19 (a) [In this section, "institution of higher education" has the
- 20 meaning assigned by Section 61.003, Education Code.
- 21 [(b)] The <u>board</u> [commission] shall <u>administer</u> [ensure] a
- 22 system to electronically monitor the use of tuition and fee
- 23 exemptions at institutions of higher education under Section
- 24 54.341[, Education Code, is developed]. The system must allow the
- 25 <u>board</u> [commission] to electronically receive, for each semester,
- 26 the following information from institutions of higher education:
- 27 (1) the name of the institution;

- 1 (2) the name, identification number, and date of birth
- 2 of each individual attending the institution and receiving benefits
- 3 for the semester under Section 54.341[, Education Code];
- 4 (3) for each individual receiving benefits, the number
- 5 of credit hours for which the individual received an exemption for
- 6 the semester;
- 7 (4) for each individual receiving benefits at the
- 8 institution during the semester, the total cumulative number of
- 9 credit hours for which the individual has received an exemption at
- 10 the institution; and
- 11 (5) any other information required by the board
- 12 [commission].
- (b) Not later than January 1, 2018, the Texas Veterans
- 14 Commission, under an agreement with the board, shall provide access
- 15 to the system developed by the commission that meets the
- 16 requirements of this section. This subsection expires September 1,
- 17 2019.
- 18 SECTION 4. Section 54.201, Education Code, as added by this
- 19 Act, applies to a person's eligibility for an exemption or waiver
- 20 from the payment of all or part of tuition or other fees beginning
- 21 with tuition and fees charged for the 2018 fall semester.
- SECTION 5. Section 54.341(h), Education Code, as amended by
- 23 this Act, applies beginning with the report for the 2018 spring
- 24 semester.
- 25 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2017.
